Courses meet the C3 Framework and the Common Core State Standards for Social Studies / ELA.

The LHEF maintains a system of Living History Supply Depots across the state which contains uniforms, equipment, tents, etc. for the use of teachers trained in the Living History approach. There are 30 depots statewide.
